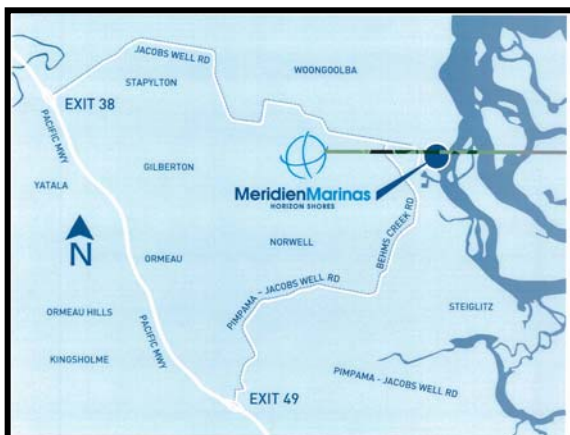

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Meridien Marinas Horizon Shores is situated half way between Brisbane and the Gold Coast easily accessible by vehicle from the M1 Pacific Hwy and known as being on the Gateway to Morton Bay. Horizon Shores is on the main Broadwater shipping channel to Brisbane and centrally located just a short distance from the Gold Coast and the well known Jumpinpin Bar.

For your convenience Meridien Marinas Horizon Shores is open from 7.30am to 5pm 7days a week catering for all of your boating needs with the supply of fuel, ice, bait, gas, and a full working shipyard with 70 ton travel lift, hardstand facilities, wet and dry storage and Long Term leasehold Berths, FOR SALE.

You will also find a high standard of commercial and industrial businesses on site, such as a fully licensed Café & Bar, Chandlery, boat hire, marine mechanics, builders, repairers, detailers, trimmers, marine electricians and more.

Local Area: Southern Moreton Bay, Jumpinpin Bar and Stradbroke Island. 40 minutes from the Southport seaway.

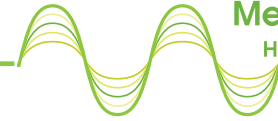
Weather forecasts are collected from the Yatala Weather Station.

MARINA SPEED LIMIT:

A maximum of 4 knots and no wash is to be observed when approaching or leaving the marina facility. When entering or leaving the marina, please observe the Maritime laws of always keeping to the right. All vessels are to enter the marina under power, assistance is available by calling the marina office.

INSURANCE:

Meridien Marinas Horizon Shores requires all vessels to have full comprehensive insurance. A current copy of insurance certificate displaying insurer, policy expiry date and vessel details must be produced at the marina office on arrival.

VESSELS:

Only currently registered vessels in a seaworthy condition and under their own power will be admitted into the marina. Upon entering the marina the vessel immediately becomes subject to the direction of Meridien Marinas Management and shall be berthed or maneuvered only where directed.

Mooring lines must be provided by the berth occupier and be adequate for the vessel's size and weight. If it is of the opinion of the Marina Management that these lines are inadequate or additional lines are necessary, the berth occupier will need to comply with this direction at their expense.

No part of any vessel may overhang a walkway, including anchors, bows, bowsprits, davits etc and decks of all craft must be kept free of all debris at all times.

Vessels may not hang For Sale signs without Marina Management approval.

FUEL:

Fueling is only permitted on the designated fuel wharf. Fueling on unauthorized docks or mooring berths is strictly prohibited.

To enable the next vessel to dock for fueling it is imperative that you fuel your vessel and depart immediately after you have finalized payment at the office. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in assisting us to make it as easy as possible for all of our customers. If more docking time is needed after fueling temporary berths are available.

WATER:

Access to water is available to all vessels moored in the marina.

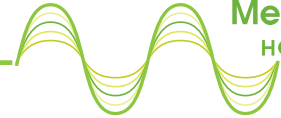
Horizon Shores Marina does not have the convenience of town water therefore we ask that the use of water in the marina be kept to a minimum at all times. The washing of vessels is only permitted if using a gurney or bucket.

POWER:

Mains shore power pedestals are situated at each berth for the use of power connection. The berth occupier is responsible for supplying their own power leads. All power leads must comply with the following:

- Leads must be 15amp
- Rated for outdoor use
- Compliant with AS/NZ 3000:2007 standards.
- Tested and tagged by a certified electrician.

Occasionally marina staff may have to disconnect your power cord if they are potentially dangerous, damaged, or laying across a walkway or if works are being carried out on piers. Staff will try to contact the vessel owner prior to doing so, however on occasion the need to unplug a cord may override this contact.



LIVING ABOARD YOUR VESSEL:

Please note: Live Aboard charges apply when staying on your vessel for longer than 3 nights per week.

ANIMALS:

Animals are not permitted to live on board a vessel in the marina unless special circumstances apply and approval has been granted by the Marina General Manager. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times whilst in the marina.

CAR PARKING:

Free parking is available at the marina for its customers, tenants and visitors however Boats, tenders, trailers, heavy loaded trucks or machinery are not permitted to use the public parking areas in the marina. Meridien Marinas Horizon Shores is not responsible for any vehicles using the marina car park.

TROLLEYS:

The marina has trolleys designated for your private use. Please see marina staff if you require a trolley. We ask that trolleys are returned to the original collection point after use.

NUISANCE:

Tenants shall be responsible for the conduct of their guests. Disorderly conduct by a customer or their guests may give rise to the cancellation of the Licence Agreement. Swimming, diving and fishing is prohibited within the marina. Children must be supervised and accompanied by an adult at all times.

LAUNDRY:

Coin operated washing machines and dryers are located at the marina laundry for your convenience. You are not permitted to hang laundry from your vessel or berth.

GARBAGE/WASTE/OIL:

Garbage collection points are clearly marked at the marina. A skip is provided for most waste while special collection points are available for oil products, used batteries. It would be appreciated if all cardboard boxes could be dismantled and flat packed before depositing in the appropriate bins.

INTERNET ACCESS:

Please contact the marina office for details on wireless internet access at the facility.

CONTRACTORS & TRADESPEOPLE:

All outside contractors must present proof of business insurance and login at the marina office prior to commencing works in the marina. Trades people must be holders of a 'Blue-Card' (construction workers only) and all tools and power leads must be tagged. Boat owners are responsible for any trades people they engage to undertake work on their vessel/s. It is the boat owner's responsibility to ensure registration has occurred and insurance and qualifications are in place.

SECURITY:

The marina is patrolled by a private security company 7 day a week. Phone: 0406 728 052

EMERGENCY EVACUATION / CYCLONE PROCEDURES:

Cyclone management plans are available at the Marina Offices.

The marina has fire and emergency evacuation procedures in place, with signage available within the facility for assembly points. Please note where fire-fighting equipment is in relation to your allocated berth.
